

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, from Friday afternoon the school is closed for most children until further notice. Those children who will be allowed to attend school will be 'vulnerable' children and those whose parents are 'key workers'. Exact definitions of these terms are yet to be received from the government. However, it is our intension to provide this service during next week and during the Easter holidays too. By knowing which children are likely to be needing this service allows us to deploy our staff effectively.

During this period of school closure, not only do we have to provide for the groups of children above but for those who are not allowed to attend school also.

## For those children not allowed to attend school:

School staff will for next week prepare and share via their class's web page activities that can be completed at home. This information will be uploaded on Monday morning and will include numeracy activities, literacy activities and other activities that can be completed during the week. The nature of these activities will vary from age group to age group. There are links to web-based sites that may also be useful to you. This will also be sent home.

Teachers will check and respond to these emails regarding children's work on a daily basis but cannot give detailed feedback on specific pieces of work.

Children still in school will be sent home with basic resources - exercise books, pencils etc - on Friday. If your child is not at school, and if it is possible to do so safely, you are welcome to collect your resources from the office.

Please can we ask that you support your child as much as possible to complete their work. However, we stress that this should not cause additional anxiety to families.

Should school closure continue after the Easter break, then we will send out work for every class via the web site each Monday and before 9.00am. There will be no work set during the holidays. In addition to the work provided, reading daily and times table practise is really important!
